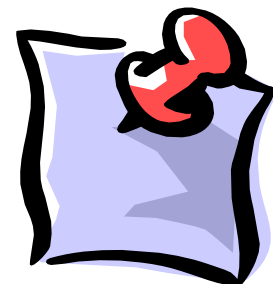

They may say, "Nobody likes me 'coz I can't run as fast as they can." Sometimes they blame everyone else for the problem and, say, "The girls are all mean to me." Even though they blame the other children they may still think of it as a problem they cannot change.

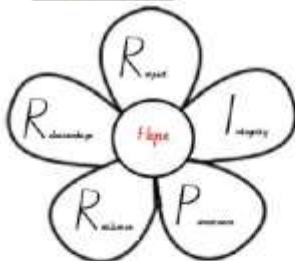
### **Restorative Practices**

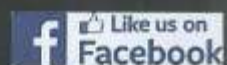
