The Light Horse Day Service

On Tuesday 31st October, thirty-five students, three members of staff and one parent volunteer represented the school at a formal ceremony at the Shrine of Remembrance to commemorate the Battle of Beersheba. On the 31st October, 1917 the 4th Light Horse Brigade charged Ottoman fortifications and Beersheba. The horse galloped straight at the Turkish trenches and took the enemy by surprise. One hundred years later, the students gathered to reflect on the actions of the light horsemen and their horses.

The Karingal Primary School students' behaviour on the day was exemplary and I was extremely proud of how well they represented the school.

Accepting and including others

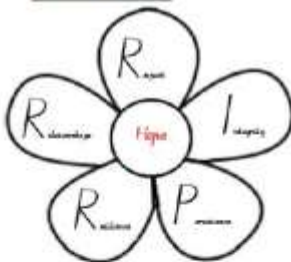
- Recognising others' needs for respect and friendship.
