



Dear Parents and Carers

On behalf of our school, I want to say a big thank you to all our students, parents and carers for your resilience and support during the week. I know remote and flexible learning is not always easy, but through our collective efforts, our student will continue to make valuable progress in their learning.

The Victorian Government has just announced an extended lockdown until Tuesday 27th July at 11:59pm.

Based on advice from the Victorian Chief Health Officer, all schools in Victoria will continue with **remote and flexible learning until Tuesday 27th July at 11:59pm.**

Existing arrangements for on-site supervision of vulnerable children and the children of authorised workers continue to be in place.

Remote and flexible learning

All students should check their school email on a daily basis as teachers will be making contact regularly via email. The teachers will use this to schedule WebEx meetings, touch base with students throughout the day, check on progress and undertake any learning support that may be necessary.

On-site supervision

Our school will provide on-site supervision for students in the following categories:

- Children whose parents and/or carers are authorised workers who cannot work from home and where no other supervision arrangements can be made, including children of teachers in government schools who are required to return to work on-site.
- children experiencing vulnerability, including:
 - children in out-of-home care
 - children deemed vulnerable by a government agency, funded family or family violence service, and assessed as requiring education and care outside the family home
 - children identified by a school or early childhood service as vulnerable, (including via referral from a government agency, or funded family or family violence service, homeless or youth justice service or mental health or other health service)

If your child requires on-site supervision please email the onsite attendance form to Samantha.Marston@education.vic.gov.au as soon as possible so we can cater for your child.

Attendance

We are asking for your support in helping us to monitor attendance accurately. Could families please check in with the classroom teacher daily. All we ask is an acknowledgement that you have seen the work (you may wish to complete it later), but it enables the teacher to mark the roll as accurately as we can.

We are currently still waiting for further advice from the Department.

This is clearly going to be another challenging time for all of us. It's going to be critically important that we work very closely together to ensure the best possible support for the ongoing wellbeing and learning of our students and your children.
